WAIVER OF EXTRADITION AND CONSENT TO RETURN

The court has informed me in open court that a demand has been made for me to be returned to another state to face charges that are pending against me in this state.

The court has informed me in open court that I have the right to legal counsel and that if I cannot hire legal counsel, I can request and receive appointed legal counsel free of charge to assist me in this matter.

The court has informed me in open court that I have the right to an extradition process, including the issuance and service of a warrant of extradition (Governor's Warrant) and that I have the right to challenge the legality of my arrest and to contest the extradition proceedings by filing a petition for habeas corpus relief pursuant to 725 ILCS 225/10.

The court has informed me in open court that I have the right to waive any challenge to my arrest and extradition proceedings and that I may consent to return to the demanding state to face the charges against me.

After consulting with counsel, I hereby exercise my right to waive any challenge to my arrest and extradition proceedings and I hereby consent to return to the demanding state to face the charges against me. I understand that by exercising my right to waive extradition, I am giving up the other rights listed above. No promises have been made to me and no threats have been made against me to get me to voluntarily return to the demanding state.

ORDER
